Information sheet for new members

Dear parents, dear members,

The Judo Club Luxembourg offers the following judo classes at its dojo*:

- for children from 4 to 6 years, Thursdays from 16:00-16:45
- for children from 6 to 10 years, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 17:00-18:00 and Saturdays from 10:30-12:00
- for children from 11 to 14 years, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 18:15-19:15
- for adolescents (+14) and adults (+17), Tuesdays and Thursdays from 19:30 until 21:30.

Persons who start the class from September until December pay a fee until the end of the same year of € 110.- if they are minor resp. € 120.- if they are adult. Persons who already are members and persons who start the class from January until June pay an annual fee of € 250.- for minors resp. € 280.- for adults.

A partial payment of the annual fee in the period from January until July is not accepted.

New members have to do the following:

1. pay the due fee and mention the last and first names of the athlete as well as the payment period;
2. complete a license application form (downloadable on our website) and a proof of payment of the due fee (see above);
3. for the persons who are interested in competition, submit to a medical exam at one of the regional "médico-sportif"-centres (compulsory for competitors from 7 to 50 years of age). On <http://www.sport.public.lu> you will find the needed information. This exam is, of course, possible at a later time, but before the 1st competition.
